

## American Legion Baseball is Back in Bedford!

Many Bedford residents grew up proudly representing our town in American Legion Baseball, but the program was dormant from 2016 through 2020. Now, young ball players have the opportunity to represent Bedford on a local, regional, and possibly even national level, as Bedford again boasts American Legion Baseball teams at levels supporting players between the ages of 13 and 19!

Our program partners with Stevens-Buswell Post 54, the Bedford American Legion Post here in town. This collaboration has resulted in state championship squads, most recently in 2011, and has helped numerous future collegiate and professional players hone their skills.

Several Post 54 coaches have Legion ball experience: head coach Henry DuBois played for Jutras Post 43 on the west side of Manchester; and Mark St. Hilaire suited up for Coffee Post 3 in Nashua.

American Legion Baseball ("Legion") was founded in 1925, and still stands behind the traditional values upon which it was founded. Legion has taught hundreds of thousands of young Americans the importance of sportsmanship, good health and active citizenship. The program is also a promoter of equality, making teammates out of young athletes regardless of their income levels or social standings.

Since its inception in 1925, the league has had millions of players, including countless who have gone on to play in college and professional baseball, with 81 inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame. The roll of players includes luminaries such as Ted Williams, Bob Feller, Yogi Berra, Frank Robinson, Albert Pujols, and Justin Verlander, among others.

With costly, pressure-laden travel baseball programs rising to prominence over the last decade, Legion offers players something difficult to find: the opportunity to play with their friends on town teams. This is a throwback to the baseball that many of us remember playing when we were younger, and offers these players a chance to play our national pastime on our fields right here in town. This allows players, fans, and town residents to experience the familiar sights and sounds of the game of baseball on beautiful New Hampshire summer afternoons and evenings.

  - Social media post
  - Website logo
  - o Total investment: \$500
- The Single: Get on base with:

  - Website logo
  - o Total investment: \$250
